

A MINISTRY BASE FOR THE NORTH





#### WHY THE HILL?

Since Modbury was planted 15 years ago, we have longed for a base where ministry could grow through the week. It's been the same for all four churches planted in the north. Sundays in school halls have been a blessing — but outside Sundays, there has been no base of our own, no visible presence in the community, & no place for midweek ministry to grow. 'The Hill' at Holden Hill changes that. Our prayer is that it will become a space buzzing with gospel life: youth gatherings, evangelistic courses and training nights, community care and celebrations, Bible studies and a place where our evening church can launch. A place where people of all ages can hear the gospel, grow in faith, and be sent out to serve.

#### HOW WE GOT HERE

After Hill Street Church closed they gifted some proceeds from the sale of their building towards establishing a hub for gospel ministry in the north. In August 2025 a property was identified & after prayer, inspections, & careful negotiation, it was purchased for \$2.6 million by a trust established for this purpose by the Trinity Church Trustees. Thanks to Hill Street's generosity much of the purchase price is covered. There is a shortfall, however, & with fees & fit-out this comes to about \$800,000. The Trinity Church Trustees have agreed to loan funds to enable the purchase, which will need to be **repaid** over time with **interest** of initially around 4%. This is a wonderful provision – but it is still debt & will restrict our future ministry if it stays on our books.

## THE CHALLENGE BEFORE US

To step into the future unhindered, our prayer as a region is to raise:

\$500,000 by the end of Nov 2025
 which would cut the amount owed down to a manageable size

If we could raise \$800,000 this would clear what we owe completely! That way, every dollar given goes into ministry, not into servicing debt.
